# Northern COLLEGE Checklist for APA Format

#### **General Formatting:**

- o Entire document is double-spaced
- o All extra spaces have been removed
- Margins are 1 inch
- o Font is Times New Roman 12
- Title page, References, Appendices are on separate pages
- o All pages are numbered in sequence, beginning with the Title Page
- o The title of your paper is no more than 12 words
- Each paragraph is longer than a single sentence but no longer than one page
- o Unnecessary abbreviations are eliminated; necessary ones are explained

### **Title Page includes:**

- o Paper title
- o Date
- Name of author
- o Name of educational institution
- Course code and name
- Name of professor
- Page numbering starting at "1"

# Citing and Referencing:

- Every reference to someone else's work has a citation (quotes, paraphrases and summaries)
- o References are cited in both text and reference list
- o In-text citations and reference list entries agree both in spelling and in date
- o Journal titles in the reference list are fully spelled out
- o References are listed in alphabetical order
- o Page numbers are provided for all articles or chapters in books in the reference list
- o Second and subsequent lines of each reference entry have a hanging indent

# Tables, Charts, Graphs:

- Original tables, charts or graphs have been given a title and referred to/explained in the body of the paper
- Tables, charts or graphs prepared by someone else have been correctly cited and referenced
- o Tables, charts or graphs prepared by someone else have a title
- Tables, charts or graphs prepared by someone else are referred to/explained in the body of the paper

• Tables, charts and graphs are used sparingly and only if they contribute to the position of the paper

#### **Appendices:**

- 0 If there is only one appendix in the paper, it is titled Appendix
- If there is more than one appendix, the title is Appendix A, Appendix B, etc.
- o Each Appendix is referred to in the body of the paper
